15 minutes

JIAF Concept

- What are the two PiN estimation scenarios?

JIAF Methodology

15 minutes

Introductory video **for those needing a more detailed review of the JIAF methodology** before going deeper into the technical application and tools.

- What is the role of intersectoral severity estimation?
- How is severity for the humanitarian conditions pillar aggregated to establish the PiN?
- What determines if you should use Scenario A or B in aggregation?

JIAF Process

15 minutes

For the JIAF analysis team, and anyone involved in the JIAF process or needing to inform others of the JIAF process steps and outputs.

- How does the JIAF link to the HPC and existing analysis processes e.g. HNO?
- Who should be in the Joint Intersectoral Analysis (JIAF) team and what should they do in each step of the process?
- What is the output of each step?

JIAF Indicators and Severity

15 minutes

Technical review of how the JIAF and HPC work in practice. Useful **for those needing in-depth explanations of the different types of indicators used in the JIAF** and how they relate to severity estimation.

- How are different indicators used in elements of the JIAF framework?
- How do you define critical indicators?
- What is the difference between magnitude and degree indicators?

JIAF Aggregation and PiN

15 minutes

Step by step explanation of PiN aggregation processes for scenarios A & B. Necessary **for those undertaking PiN aggregation and/or those needing to explain to others how the process works.**

- What is the difference between scenario A and scenario B for aggregation, their requirements, and outputs?
- What data is needed for the two scenario options?
- Where can I go for help with the process?

JIAF Good Practices

15 minutes

Review of linkages between the JIAF and the HNO useful **for those involved in the JIAF process** requiring good practice examples of its application.

- What is the connection between the JIAF and the HNO?
- What are some good examples of how the JIAF and HNO have been linked?
- What are the key observations for the HNO regarding JIAF linkages?

JIAF Coordination Setup

15 minutes

In-depth explanation of the analysis process, including developing work plans, defining roles and responsibilities, and setting a realistic time frame to complete the work.

- Who is responsible for what actions and deliverables in the process (OCHA, HCT/ICCG/Clusters)?
- What does the ICCG do in this process?
- How should the analysis team be set up?
- What are the steps in the process and is there an example timeline?

JIAF Overview for InterCluster Coordinators and HPC Focal Points

15 minutes

This video is designed specifically **for ICCG members and HPC focal points** and may also be of interest to those who need to understand the linkages between the process and structures of the JIAF and the HPC.

- How do the HPC timeline and JIAF process connect?
- What are the 5 steps in the JIAF process?
- What does a JIAF ICCG workplan look like?
- What is an HPC kick-off workshop and what is covered in it?

JIAF Helpdesk guidance

The **JIAF Interagency Helpdesk is available for field practitioners to raise questions and obtain clarifications and expert advice on how to apply the JIAF methodology.** Technical experts from OCHA and all global clusters are part of the JIAF Helpdesk. Where possible, queries on the JIAF should be solved at country level.

In case a query cannot be resolved at country level, it should be shared with global counterparts (e.g. a cluster IMO in country will contact the global cluster IMO, OCHA in-country will contact the global HPC focal point). The relevant JIAF focal point at global level will then coordinate with the helpdesk for support.
